What is a Title?

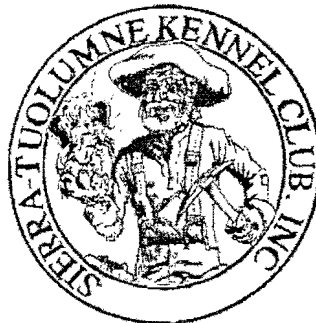

Heimlich Maneuver for Dogs

Place your dog on its side and, using both hands, palms down, apply quick thrusts to the abdomen just below the dog's last rib. If the dog won't lie down, grasp either side of the rib cage & squeeze in short thrusts. Make a sharp enough movement to cause the air in the lungs to force the object out.

Can Dogs See in Color?

People always want to know if dogs can see in color, says Dr. Denis Brooks DVM, U of Fl. "Well, no, not like humans, but they certainly see some colors. Dogs can distinguish shades of blue, indigo and violet well, and maybe a dim yellow. They don't see the colors of red or green very well at all. Red appears dark to dogs and green can't really be distinguished from white."

Dr. Brooks has found that a dog's visual acuity is about 75% of that of a human, meaning that a dog sees only about 3/4 of the detail that we see. In visual terms, your dog would have to be 20 feet from an object to perceive it as well as you do at 75 feet. Dogs do, however, surpass humans at detecting motion. For instance, dogs see not only the images on TV, they also see the scrolling lines that move at 60 lines per second. Dogs also surpass humans when it comes to seeing in dim light. Dogs have good night vision.
