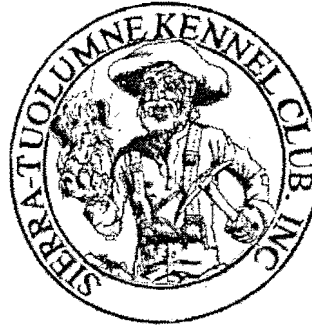

Decision to looking into another shed, approximately 14 x 20. Augie has information.


New Business
